Mr. Walton helped create the Education Foundation in 1981 while serving as President of the LAR. The Foundation was renamed in his honor in 2016. Mr. Walton was a pillar of the LAR, humbly serving throughout his life. He also served as President of the Texas Association of REALTORS® in 1999 and was appointed to the Texas Real Estate Commission by Governor Rick Perry from 2001 to 2007. In 2004, Governor Perry appointed him as Chairman of the Commission.

At the discretion of the John S Walton Educational Foundation, one thousand-dollar (\$1,000) scholarships will be awarded to chosen applicants and paid directly to the school of higher education in which they will attend.

Requested Information & Documentation:

- Completed Applicant Profile
- Most recent transcript with Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Essay of no more than one thousand (1,000) words detailing the applicants need for the scholarship, how it will help further his or her education and plans for the future
- Recommendation letter from an active REALTOR® member of the Lubbock Association of REALTORS®
- Resume

Applicant Requirements:

- Recipient must be a U.S. Citizen, permanent citizen or studying on a student visa.
- Recipient must be accepted or attending Texas Tech University, South Plains College, Lubbock Christian University or Wayland Baptist University.
- Recipient must be at least a full-time (12-semester credit hours) student.
- Recipient must be an entering freshman or a returning student.
- Returning student recipients must have and maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average.
- Recipients will be notified of scholarship awards no later than **May 8, 2020**.
