

Homesnap - How to claim your profile

omesnap has some great features but are you taking advantage of all of them? Did you know you can get information about any home, whether its on the market or not, just by taking a picture of it? You can also brand yourself as a REALTOR® on the consumer version? And soon you'll have the ability to see any attached documents on a property within the Homesnap app.

If you haven't claimed your Homesnap Pro account, you need to. Not only are you missing out on a great tool to use in your business, there is a ton of great information on the Homesnap blog.

Although there is only one Homesnap app, there are two versions - a consumer version called

Homesnap Pro+ version of the app.

Homesnap and the Homesnap Pro+version for agents.

The Pro+ version does have a fee to use it. You can find out more about it by visiting <a href="https://www.homesnap.com">homesnap.com</a>. Once you login, click on Pro+ Upgrade to learn more about Homesnap Pro+.

New agents can claim their Homesnap profile a couple different ways. Homesnap will send you an email with a link to claim your profile a couple of weeks after you join LAR. You can also visit the Homesnap app and claim your profile manually.




This class by Reba Saxon will help agents understand and explain lending advantages and disadvantages, general financial terms in the contract, loan processes, and closing costs to clients.

Agents will increase negotiation skills beyond the basics to encompass multiple offers and presentations, backup offers and contingencies.












## NAR Flash Survey: Economic Pulse

AR conducted a flash survey of members on the impact of the coronavirus on their market.

Of those who are working with home sellers with active listings, the majority reported changing how their clients' homes are viewed while the home remains on the market.

92% reported that home sellers have made changes, including stopping open houses or requiring all those who enter the home to take appropriate precautions before entering the home.

Contributions to the Texas Association of REALTORS® Political Action Committee (TREPAC) and the Texas Association of REALTORS® Federal Political Action Committee (TAR FedPAC)—which makes contributions to the REALTORS\* Political Action Committee (RPAC)—are voluntary and may be used for political purposes. The amount indicated is merely a guideline, and you may contribute more or less than the suggested amount. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal, and the National Association of REALTORS\*, the Texas Association of REALTORS\* (TAR), and its local associations will not favor or disadvantage anyone because of the amount contributed. Until the RPAC annual goal is met, 70% of an individual's contribution goes to TREPAC and may be used to support state and local candidates; the remaining 30% is sent to TAR FedPAC to support federal candidates and is charged against your limits under 52 U.S.C. 30116.
