LAR endorses Frenship ISD bond

AR joined forces with the Lubbock Chamber, the Lubbock Apartment Association, and the West Texas Homebuilders Association to show support for the Frenship ISD's upcoming bond election on Wednesday, October 7 at a press conference held at the People's Bank

President Ken Harlan addressed the attendees and news media on behalf of the association.

"Strong schools help build strong communities," Harlan said. "Which in turn, creates more opportunities for homeownership."

The total bond amount will be \$299,700,000, which Frenship ISD will use to add a second high school, another middle school and elementary school. It will also be used to renovate existing schools.

The monthly impact on homeowners would be about \$1.12 and annually \$13.44. If the bond passes, it would raise the tax rate from \$1.42 per \$100 valuation to \$1.4281 per \$100 valuation.

The 2020 LAR Vendor Fair is coming soon!


Mark your calendars now for this fun annual event!



Tonya's MLS Tips and Tricks

Learn how to use Trendgraphix to access important stats for your listings

rendgraphix is a powerful tool with lots of charts and graphs, and options to further refine and customize the information. Access to this information can be found in three places:

- 1. In Rapattoni it is in the black toolbar under Trends.
- 2. On the LAR website in Quick Links as TrendVision
- 3. In the buttons below the red menu as Trends Statistics

It is very easy to use, but there is a lot of information. It may seem overwhelming at first. If you don't find what you need on your own, I'm available to schedule a hands-on demonstration that will cover:

- How to fill out the search criteria to use the charts and tables
- The five tabs in the main section. Each tab contains a drop down list of up to 10 reports.
- Each report contains a graph and a table of information, but there is also a Market Highlight that contains a summary of the information in the report
- Above the tabs are buttons to Email, Print, Save Graph, Market Summary and Post-2-Web, making it easy to share this information in almost any way you can think of.
- The Post-2-Web option allows you to get the HTML code to post to your website and can also include a lead generation form, and the Market Highlights.

- Need help talking about the information found here? Click on the "i" in the green button at the very top left hand corner. This contains tips on talking to buyers and sellers about Supply and demand, price per square foot, DOM, and average prices. There are also videos and transcripts of the text from the videos as well.
- The Glossary of Data Terms in the top right corner
- The Quick Guide also contains valuable information including how it is calculated, its purpose, how to use it, and what you should know.
- In the Search Criteria there are several options in the Select a Location section including county, city, and zip code. You can only select one Location, however, you can select multiple items within that location. Multiple zones or multiple subzones, but not a zone and a subzone. The zip code locations do not work at this time.
- When using the Search Criteria Select a Location, remember the "Area" is our zone, and the "subdivision" is our sub-zone
- There are Property Types and Price Range options
- In the Select Date Range, there are predefined date ranges on a quarterly and annual basis going back 15 years, and 15 month reports going back 15 years.

However, we only started using Rapattoni on December 10, 2013.

- There are drop downs for square foot range, condition of sale, bedrooms, full baths, half baths, and year built located below the Date Range in the search criteria.
- When using the search criteria section, be sure to click one of the show chart buttons located at the top and bottom of the section.
- Once you click the show chart button you have access to all the charts and tables in the main section, customized to your search criteria.

New construction showings using the ShowingTime App

e have been made aware of an ongoing problem when agents are showing new construction properties without using the ShowingTime app. Many of these properties have security systems and agents have

been entering without the security code to turn off the alarm. This results in a false alarm fee the builder is required to pay.

It is imperative that if you show a new construction property, you access it through the ShowingTime app. The alarm security code is available through ShowingTime app. If you have questions about how to use ShowingTime or need help accessing a listing, please call LAR at 806-795-9533.
