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While the housing market seems to be cooling after a hot year, some home prices have stayed up, especially when they come with a luxury label. So, what makes a luxury home with a price tag of \$1 million or higher in Lubbock?

According to the Lubbock Association of Realtors, location, amenities and more factor in to luxury homes and luxury prices. Here's a look into the top 10 most expensive, luxurious, single-family homes in Lubbock as of Wednesday, Oct. 26. As a note, these are listed as single-family homes and does not include homes marked as contingent or pending.

No. 10: 4902 115th St.

List price: \$1,200,000

Size: 5,404 sq. ft.

Year built: 2013

Bedrooms and bathrooms: 4 bedrooms, 4 bathrooms and two half-baths.

Features: This Clearview Custom Homes design in Oakmont shows off high ceilings, a sauna in the master suite, an outdoor kitchen, a safe/gun room, hot tub, swimming pool, and media room with a projector. The home also had insulation upgraded to become more energy efficient recently.

No. 9: 4509 17th St.

List price: \$1,200,000

Size: 4,956 sq. ft.

Features: Located in the Sedonna Addition lays the most expensive new construction on the market. Still in the construction process, the listing promises a basement with a wet bar and space for a pool table or video games. The outdoor area claims an outdoor kitchen with a fridge and sink, a heated pool and hot tub, and fire pots.

No. 1: 2404 York Ave.

List price: \$2,800,000

Size: 13,485 sq. ft.

Year built: 2000

Bedrooms and bathrooms: 7 bedrooms, 8 full bathrooms and 2 half-baths.

Features: Within the Coronado Neighborhood in Central Lubbock rests the most expensive home on the market – The Lincoln Estate House. Sporting a tennis court and swimming pool, along with a greenhouse, the property covers 1.6 acres. There are three kitchens, a 3-car garage, parlors and a finished basement. The listing suggests it would make an ideal bed and breakfast.

By Thursday, Oct. 27, realtor.com had 16 homes listed at \$1 million or more. Seven of those homes are new constructions.

Three homes listed at \$1.2 million entered the market on Thursday at 3220 21st St., 3406 County Road 7610 and 3515 154th St. Since January 2022, 42 million-dollar homes have sold. The average luxury sales price is \$1,350,782.

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
